March 16, 2026 – The ASME Foundation, the philanthropic arm of The American Society of Mechanical Engineers, together with ROSEN Group, today announced the opening of the Call for Projects for the *2026 Hermann Rosen Award for Pipeline Innovation*. Endowed by the ROSEN Group and awarded annually, the prize recognizes emerging innovators whose work has the potential to meaningfully advance pipeline safety, integrity, and performance. The winner will receive a USD 25,000 award to support the further development of their idea.
